

# How to get to the University of Fribourg (Main location : Miséricorde)

- Arrival at Geneva Airport or Zurich Airport: At Geneva and Zurich Airports the train stations
  are directly connected to the terminal buildings. From Geneva, direct trains to Fribourg run
  approximately every 30 minutes throughout the day. From Zurich Airport there are two trains
  per hour as well, one direct, one connecting in Bern.
- Arrival at Basel-Mulhouse Airport: Bus take you from the Swiss side of the arrivals hall to
  the railway station ("Basel SBB"). Direct trains from Basel to Bern and connecting trains from
  Bern to Fribourg run approximately every 30 minutes throughout the day.

### • Arrival at Fribourg train station

The University of Fribourg, Miséricorde is about 5 minutes walking distance from the train station, and about 15 minutes walking distance from the Hotel de la Rose (Rue de Morat 1). The quickest and easiest way is to walk to the University.

#### Arrival by car

You may leave the motorway either at "Fribourg Nord", "Fribourg Centre" or "Fribourg Sud", and then follow City Centre.

#### Buses in the city:

If you want to take the bus from the train station to the Hotel de la Rose: bus Nr 1, Direction *Portes de Fribourg* (but stop not at the exit of the train station, but on the other side of the road). The ticket for the bus costs SFr. 2.90.

FACULTÉ DE DROIT BUREAU ERASMUS ET DES RELATIONS INTERNATIONALES Leave the bus at the bus stop *Tilleul / Cathédrale*. To reach the hotel, cross the road, and walk about 50 meters.
